Each quartet is responsible for securing its own hotel reservation at the **Crowne Plaza** in Addison, TX. The hotel cost is \$95 per night. Check-in begins at 3:00 p.m./check-out by noon. Don't dilly dally around. Make your reservations right away! The reduced rate is not available after the deadline. Reservations must be made by **1/5/2012** in order to secure the special **\$95.00** rate.

To make reservations:

- Call **972-980-8877** and push **1** for reservations.
- Request the group rate for **Sweet Adelines Region 25** or ask for the block code **RGR**

For **Online Reservations**:

- The 3 letter booking code is **RGR** and the cutoff date is **1/5/2012**
- Go to [www.cpgalleria-nr.crowneplaza.com](http://www.cpgalleria-nr.crowneplaza.com)
- Go to the left hand column and check availability
- Click on the calendar to the dates they need to reserve (day in and day out)
- Have the Guests enter the 3 letter code **RGR**
- Click on **check availability** once the dates and block code have been entered
- They will see what availability we have, and move forward with booking their reservation.

**Reminders:** All quartets must have a room for coaching sessions. If you are not staying at the hotel, it is YOUR responsibility to make other arrangements (i.e., share another quartet's room during their off hours.) All four parts must be present for coaching, and you must have at least one (1) song off paper. Please note on the registration form if you will be sharing a room to avoid scheduling issues.

A complete schedule will be forwarded in January. For planning purposes, the basic schedule is:

**Friday, January 27** - Registration opens at 6:00. New regional song and a class by Lori Lyford.

**Saturday, January 28** - Classes and coaching all day

**Saturday, January 28** - Singing and other fun stuff from 8:00 until about 10:00 pm.
